Eligibility

Open to players born in 1976 or earlier. Membership in a club is not required. All players must provide a FIDE ID upon registration. Players without a FIDE ID can apply for one for the German Federation via the DSB as described at <https://www.schachbund.de/fide-identifikationsnummer.html>.

Mode

9 rounds Swiss system, DWZ and Elo evaluation. In the event of a tie, the Elo average of the opponents (with one score discarded) will be used as a tiebreaker. The current FIDE rules apply. The waiting time is 30 minutes.

Time limit

90 min/40 moves plus 30 min remaining time, plus 30 s/move (Fischer short).

Entry fee

For transfers made by September 1, 2026, the entry fee is 75 €; thereafter, it is 80€. Grandmasters (GM) and International Masters (IM) are exempt from the entry fee, if they register before 1 July 2026. If the tournament is canceled by the organizer, the entry fee will be refunded in full. In the case of cancellation by the participant, a handling fee of 15€ will be retained.
